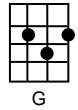


A Little Bit Is Better Than Nada

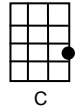

He met her in a border town, they proceeded to get down

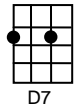

She turned him on, he dropped the telephone

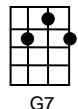
